

Article 116: The Chaos of Oneness –part 2

If you have followed our words (Article 115), you are beginning to understand the creative importance of your image of life and God ~your lifegodimage~ for that is the true image of the self and life you are living ...and frequently struggling with and against ...or denying. “Why”, you might ask, “would I ever deny my image of God? ...or struggle against that?” The answer is simple: because, in previous lives and situations, when religious beliefs and teachings controlled all of life and society, even in what we’ve come to consider as primitive cultures, God (Supreme Being, Creator, Father, Prime Mover) was supreme, and the image of that supremacy was established by religious beliefs and doctrines, legends, and sacred illustrations and songs; ...there was no place for or real acceptance of differing images ...and certainly no place for you to proclaim that you had a personal image of God ...or that you were the image of God. As a result, you substituted an established religious image of God for your own, ...or you let that overshadow your own image ...until you could no longer distinguish your own image of God ...or truly know yourself, ...and you’ve been struggling with life and against yourself ever since.

Ohh, there are many, many reasons for denying your image of God ...and religions offer even more reasons for you to deny yourself, ...but we are asking you to end those struggles and denials ...and begin living the most supreme self and life you desire. After all, you are endowed with God’s conscious free will to manifest as you truly desire, ...but you must bring god’s form(lessness) to life.

When we asked you to “declare yourself and your meaningful purpose” (Article 107-109) we were asking you to acknowledge the image of life and God you are living, for without that, all things are vague shadows ...and you are living your life in a fog. Ohh, you’ll probably disagree with this ...simply because you see things around you plainly enough, so you can’t be living in a fog, ...isn’t that right? But those things in your life which you see clearly are like the moisture-particles of the fog which, when focused upon, keep you from seeing anything clearly ...and you do not know where you are, where you’ve been, or where you’re going. To see clearly, you must change your view ...and stop focusing on the indistinguishable particles all around you ...especially those right in front of you. Only by relating all things to the steady and reliable image you have given to life’s and God’s form(lessness) ~your lifegodimage~ will you see clearly and understand wisely, ...for that steady, reliable image is you. And when we ask you to live your “declared self”, your “meaningful purpose”, or “the self and life you truly desire”, it is your lifegodimage we are asking you to be and live

By acknowledging your “present selfimage” and your “greatest and finest selfimage” you will know where you are, what diversity and individuality you are manifesting and living, and where you are headed in

life, ...but, unfortunately, these images are ever-changing ...so you have no steady, reliable “fixed point” to make sense of your self and life and shadows, ...for such a trustworthy point must be a vision or image you are willing to be and live forever: that is you, ...your Godselfimage! Indicate your image of God and claim that, ...for that is your trueselfimage.

Declare yourself and live that!

Following are definitions of words and phrases as used in Articles 114-115:

chaos: *Random, without a recognizable pattern, ...like the number for pi which after millions of numbers shows no repeatable or even recognizable pattern.*

consciousness: *The ability to actively and knowingly exist and manifest the self and life you truly desire.*

creation-tools of conscious free will: *Beliefs, thoughts, attitudes, emotions, words, and actions through which you selfevident the self and life you truly desire one-constituent-at-a-time.*

free will: *Right and empowerment. Free will is selfevident, ...which is always living as you truly desire. And since all events, situations, circumstances, and individuals reveal the self and life you are living, when selfevident or living your free will, all things are as you desire and never require reactions or choices. Separate choice from free will, ...for if you have a choice to make, that choice reveals you have *not* been living your free will as selfevident ...or you wouldn't have created the necessity/opportunity/ situation for choosing between different or opposing matters or options. But, having brought or lived yourself to a choice, you must now make a “non-free will choice” to return to selfevident the self and life you truly desire. All judgments reveal your forsaking free will ...and lack of selfevident the self and life you truly desire. Is any judgment worth such a terrible loss?*

habit: *Struggling against or trying to break or end, any habit is like tying yourself to a tiger ...such that every effort to escape or free yourself only awakens and irritates the tiger. Instead of struggling to release or change a habit, selfevident the self and life you truly desire ...and the unwanted habit or tiger will fade away. Struggle keeps you bound to the tiger and afraid to move. Be wiser than that!*

individuality: *Wholly as you desire ...without separation from all other creations ...or from the chaos of oneness.*

infinite-patterning: *Infinite here means *all/every* ...and patterning is *possibilities*. Used together, though pattern implies “a formed plan or diagram or model, infinite-patterning is *infinite-unformed possibilities*,*

...however, these possibilities are not just random. *Patterning is the assurance that whatever possibilities are manifested, they will be consistent with all prior and subsequent manifestations ...and make sense to the manifesting consciousness.* Infinite-patterning is like an invisible infinite-piano upon which you may play or manifest any sound or song you individually desire, regardless of how that sounds to others, knowing that your sound or song will be consistent with all of your own or others' prior and future sounds and songs played on that infinite-piano.

lifegodimage: The original image and form you manifested for life and God to bring them to life; bring them to form and expression. This is your trueselfimage ...which provides a constant and reliable "fixed point" for knowing yourself and all things in your life.

manifest: *Give form to formlessness.*

oneness: Oneness as unformed possibilities is infinite-patterning; as form without pattern or separation is chaos; as sensible form or pattern without separation is life.

selfimage: *Pattern for selfevidencing the self and life you truly desire.*

sense: As in "This will make sense to you", *sense is an awareness or understanding which is aroused or awakened through and consistent with mental-physical associations with prior and possible manifestations.*

visualize: *Pattern for manifesting.*
