

## Article 363: What If?

Have you ever *really considered* that what you call “spirit or your spirit dies when your body dies? I don’t mean that there is only one lifetime and then “nothing”, but that your body and spirit are both extinguished at death, ...however...

You would say that light presents as both a wave and a particle ...and when you turn the light off, you turn off both wave and particle, you don’t turn off the particle and leave the wave waving on, ...so why ever would you consider that when your body turns off ...you continue waving? Have I screwed enough with your mind and old sacred beliefs and hopes? ...and created deep concerns?
